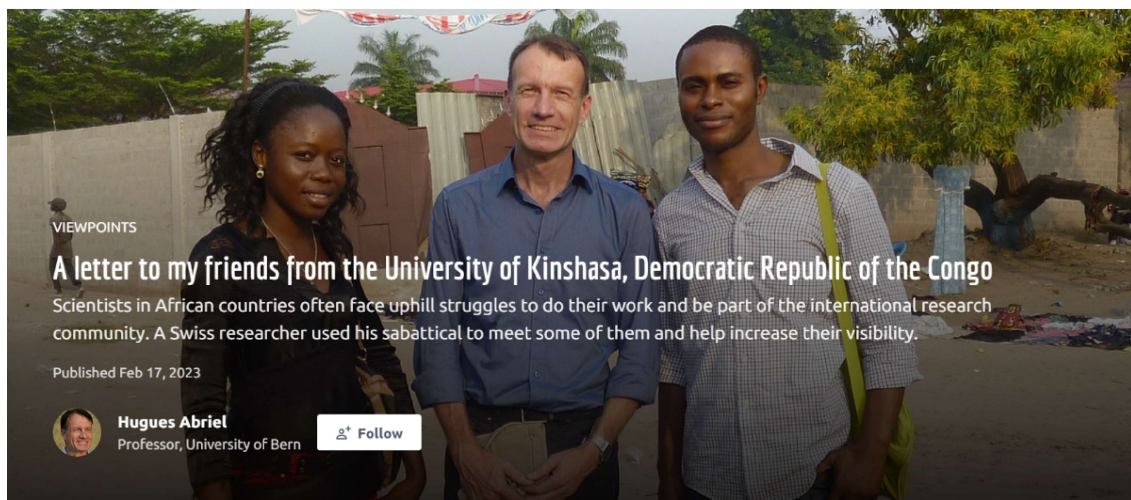
BBA Rising Star winners will receive:
