The flagship initiative of Prof. Avadhesha Surolia, SERB Distinguished Fellow, Honorary Professor, Molecular Biophysics Unit, Indian Institute of Science, Surolia award will be one of its kind in India recognizing Excellence in Glycobiology, including Glycoscience and Glycotechnology, Cell Membrane and Cell Surface at national and international level.







Major Award

Innovation Award

The major award aims to bonour experts at the global level for Excellence in research in Glycobiology including Glycoscience and Glycotechnolgy, Cell Membrane and Cell Surface. There is one award in this category, and the frequency of the award is biennial. The recipient of this award will receive a citation and ₹ 2,50,000 award money and ₹ 1,00,000 (for travel and a 2-night stay at Hotel).

The Innovation Award aims to honour young scientists and students 35 years or below for their outstanding achievements in respective fields in six divisions of IISe: Chemical Science, Physical & Mathematical Science, Biological Science, Mechanical Science, Electrical, Electronics and Computer Science (EECS) and Interdisciplinary Science. Recipients of this award will receive a citation and ₹ 20,000 award money. There are six awards in this category, three each in science and engineering, and the frequency of the award is: three awards every year.
