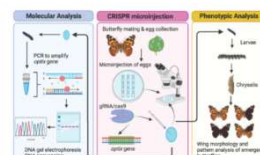

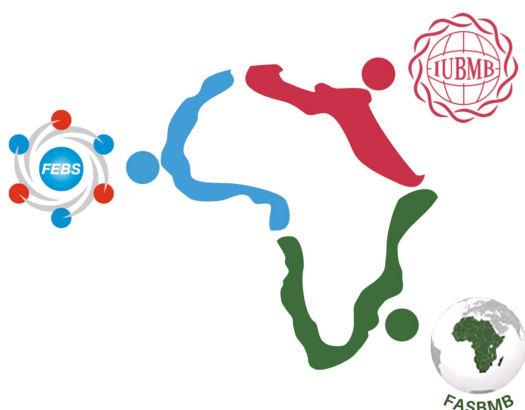


Don't give in to "lab guilt"
